The Champions of Diversity fundraising challenge wherein Bay Area law firms compete against each other to raise the most donations for the Bay Area Urban Debate League (BAUDL). BAUDL develops and supports debate teams and competitions for talented students of color who attend schools in low-income areas. Students confront world issues—this year, water justice.

Firms sort into two divisions, based on their numbers of Bay Area attorneys:

Elite Division: 60 or fewer attorneys **Grand Division:** More than 60 attorneys



The top three firms in each division will be recognized for 1st, 2nd and 3rd place finishes, with their names to be added to the Champions of Diversity trophies.
